Camp Rules

1. The purpose of this camp is to pass onto campers some of the rich heritage of our forefathers. This includes yoga exercises, mauna, lectures, discussions, etc.
2. All campers must participate in the activities assigned to them.
3. Campers are **NOT** allowed to leave the Shiva Mandir grounds without permission from the teachers. No exceptions.
4. Campers must wear loose fitting clothes only.
 - A. Girls must wear long pants and T-Shirts · No Jeans
 - B. Boys can wear either $\frac{3}{4}$ pants or long pants and T-Shirts · No Short Pants

(Required because of exercises and other activities)
5. Campers must wear their name badges at all times while in camp.
6. Campers must leave their folders, name badges and all other loaned materials (pens, pencils etc.) with their group leaders before going home.
7. The group leaders must safely store all loaned materials in group boxes at the end of the day.
8. Every morning campers must report to their group leaders (or co-leaders) to get their folders and name badges. Only the group leaders are allowed to interfere with group boxes.
9. Every morning group leaders must get attendance report to camp leaders.
10. Campers are required to show respect to all camp leaders, group leaders and co-leaders at all times. In addition, the campers must listen and follow instructions given to them.

Everyone attending the camp must follow the above rules.
